## North Central Little League Umpires

North Central Little League is recruiting Adults and High School students (Boys & Girls) to serve as Field Umpires for the Spring Little League season. NCLL sponsors ~45 teams of T-Ball, Coach Pitch, Niners, Minors, Majors, Junior and Senior divisions within the North Seattle area.

We are seeking enthusiastic and fun people to augment our current Umpire corps.

Umpires will typically work one game per week for the 10-week season. You will be paired with an experienced Umpire for each game, and can work up to serving as the Home Plate (Chief) Umpire for future seasons if approved by the league's Umpire Coordinator.

Training is provided for both Game Rules and Field Mechanics during the month of March, with ongoing on-field training

as well as group training sessions.

**No prior Umpire experience is necessary.**

However, some prior baseball experience and general knowledge of the game is required.

Positions are needed for the Niners (9 yr old), Minors (10 yr old) and Majors (11 & 12) and Juniors (13-14) divisions.

Girls Softball (9-12) positions are also needed.

## Service Hours Credit and Game Times

**Service Hours** credits for High School and College students are earned for both training hours and games. Check with your Activities Office at your school for details on the tracking of hours for credit.

### Games Times

Games are generally played on week-days from 5:30- 7:30, with multiple games on Saturdays from 9:00 – 4:30
